

PREFIX, ROOT, SUFFIX

Prefix is a word part that is added to the beginning of a word. A prefix changes the meaning of a word.

Examples: rewrite, bicycle, triangle, subway, unhappy, hexagon, octopus

Root is a word or part of a word that is used as a base for making other words.

Examples: easy-easily – uneasy.

Suffix is a word part that added to the end of a word. A suffix changes the meaning of a word.

Examples: enjoyable, teacher, biggest, lately, useful
