## CONSONANTS and VOWELS

The alphabet is the set of letters that is used in writing. There are 26 letters of the English alphabet. The alphabet is made up of consonants and vowels.

The consonants are $\mathbf{b}, \mathbf{c}, \mathbf{d}, \mathbf{f}, \mathbf{g}, \mathbf{h}, \mathbf{j}, \mathbf{k}, \mathbf{l}, \mathbf{m}, \mathbf{n}, \mathbf{p}, \mathbf{q}, \mathbf{r}, \mathbf{s}, \mathbf{t}, \mathbf{v}, \mathbf{w}$, $\mathbf{x}$, and $\mathbf{z}$.

The letter $\mathbf{y}$ is often a consonant, but in some words it's a vowel.
The vowels are $\mathbf{a}, \mathbf{e}, \mathbf{i}, \mathbf{o}$, and $\mathbf{u}$.

Color the star blue if it has a vowel on it. Color the star yellow if it has a consonant on it.
